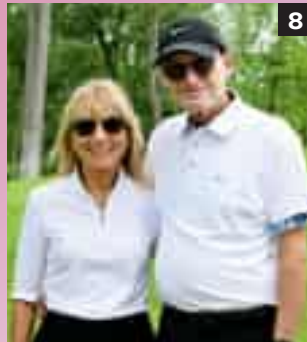

Congratulations to the 2024 MISSIVES who graduated in July. The 25 eager students ranging in age from sixteen to twenty-two, could be seen roaming the halls this summer in their recognizable blue shirts.

MISSIVE (Maimonides Intensive Summer Session for Individual Volunteer Experience) is a unique summer volunteer internship program for students, many of who are contemplating a career in a healthcare-related profession.

THERE'S A BUZZ AT DBM

Something buzzworthy is happening at Donald Berman Maimonides this summer. The Centre is collaborating with local beekeeper Yoav Sasportas from Apiguru who has set up two beehives in the garden—Each is home to up to 55,000 honey bees. They are protected with a fence to prevent residents or staff from getting too close.

“Honeybees are important pollinators for flowers, fruits, and vegetables” says Sasportas, adding, “Donald Berman Maimonides is making significant improvements for future generations by preserving bees and other pollinators with the on-site beehives.”

Residents will reap the rewards of fresh honey produced by the bees at harvest time in the Fall, perfect timing for Rosh Hashanah when it is customary to dip apples in honey for a sweet New Year. The program is being funded by the CIUSSS and the DBM Foundation.

COMMEMORATIVE BENCHES LEAVE A LASTING LEGACY

As part of the garden beautification project at DBM, new eco-friendly benches have been installed all over this green space. Two benches were recently dedicated in memory of loved ones.

UPGRADED GARDEN AREA

DID YOU KNOW?

- Honeybees are capable of stinging but unlike wasps, they are generally not aggressive and will not sting unless provoked.
- In their short life, each bee produces approximately a teaspoon of honey.
- The life span of worker honey bees ranges from five to seven weeks. The first few weeks of a worker’s life are spent working within the hive, while the last weeks are spent foraging for food and gathering pollen or nectar.

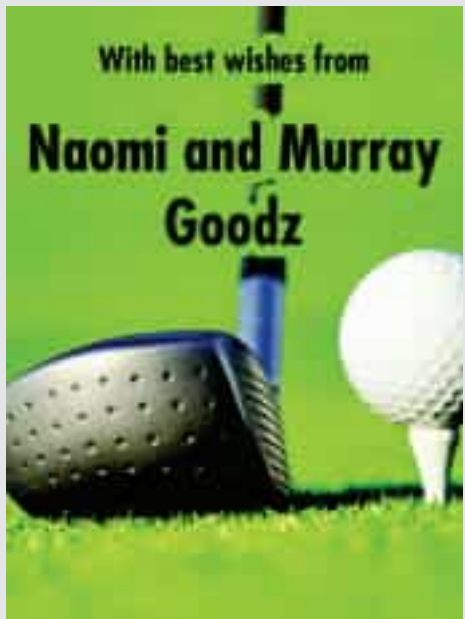

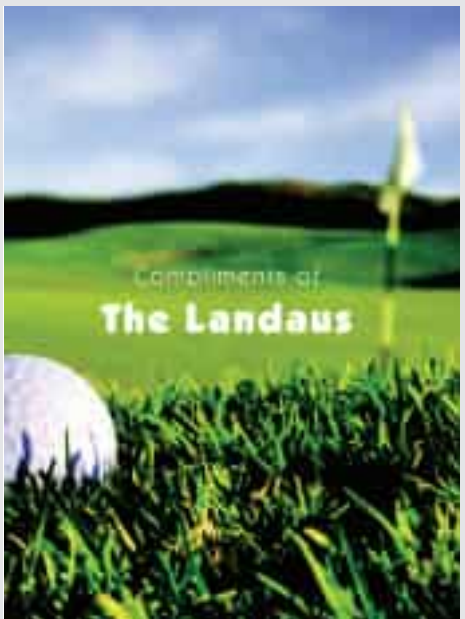
