Bringing colour to our residents

DANCE CREATES MOMENTS OF JOY

One of the latest activities at Donald Berman Maimonides and Donald Berman Jewish Eldercare is Dance.

The long-term care Centres have partnered with *Mouvement de passage* to bring dance to residents in their rooms. “The dance is not choreographed.

Each interaction is unique,” says dance artist Ariane Boulet, adding “It’s a walk-about where the movement is adapted in response to the resident’s reactions. This creates a beautiful non-verbal relationship. Oftentimes a deep connection is made.”

Dance is currently offered once a month at each site thanks to funding from the Donald Berman Maimonides and Donald Berman Jewish Eldercare Foundations. During each session, the dancer and a musician interact with 10-15 residents.



THE SMELL OF FRESH BREAD EVOKES AN AROMA OF MEMORIES

Nothing beats the smell of a freshly-baked loaf of bread. The distinct aroma can be a powerful trigger for positive memories and emotions. Now, the smell of fresh-baked bread is being used to provide sensory stimulation for residents at DBM and DBJ as well as some of the other long-term care sites in CIUSSS West-Central Montreal. The project is the brain-child of CIUSSS Immediate Past Board President Alan Maislin.

Once a week, at each Centre, the bread is baked in a bread-maker by a member of the Recreation team. “Residents’ eyes light up when they smell the freshly baked bread. It connects them

to home. For those with dementia, it can trigger memories and be a source of comfort and connection to their past,” says Elisabeta Pamint, Assistant to the Director of SAPA (Support Program for the Autonomy of Seniors), who is overseeing the project.
